She drove busses for many sporting events, worked in the lunchroom, spent time as a substitute teacher, and volunteered for many Rustler events. She sadly passed away in 2021 after a 3-month battle with Glioblastoma, an aggressive form of brain cancer. Her hard work, care for her community, and love for her family and friends will be remembered through this scholarship and carried on by its recipients.
